I am an ambulance driver employed by the West Midlands Regional Health Authority.

At about 8.35pm on Thursday 21st November 1974 as a result of a radio message I went to the Tavern in the Town, New Street, Birmingham. On arrival there at the scene I saw that several people were being put into various vehicles all of these were injured.

I took responsibility for a female body taken from the Tavern in the Town. I transported this body from there to the Accident Hospital. This was given a number at the time body number 1. (Page 1...)

On arrival at the Accident Hospital Doctor Tachakran came to the ambulance and certified the body dead. I then took the body to the Central Mortuary where it was given a further number 2792.

I was present at the Central Mortuary on Thursday 28 November 1974. When the body was identified as Maureen Ann Roberts
