My father has worked at the Rover Factory at the Tyseley Division for at least the last twenty five years as a Foreman Electrician and has always led an active and industrious life.

The last time I saw my father was on about the 16th September, 1974, when he visited my wife and myself at our home in **DPA** and at that time he was in good health.
