"On the 10th of August, 1965, I married Hilda TURNER. At that time Hilda had a son Neil Robert MARSH, who was born on the 30th November, 1956. We all lived together here at 108 Onibury Road. We also have one other son as the result of our marriage, **DPA**

DPA Neil attended a local Secondary school and left when he was 15 years of age. In June of this year Neil left home to live with some friends, **DPA**

We did not know where he had gone to live. He did come back to see us on occasions but he did not tell us where he lived. When he left home he was working as a trainee welder but he didn't always go to work. I have not seen him since he left home as I was out when he visited.

On Thursday, the 28th November, 1974, I went to the Coroner's Court in Newton Street. In the Mortuary I identified the body of my step-son Neil Robert MARSH to Police Sergeant BEDFORD and Dr. H. THOMPSON.
