I am Police Constable 2255 of the West Midlands Police. I am at present stationed at Steelhouse Lane Police Station.

On Thursday, 21st November, 1974, I was engaged on duty in New Street, City. I was engaged there in connection with the bomb incidents that had occurred at the Mulberry Bush and Tavern in the Town public houses.

At about 3.45 a.m. on Friday, 22nd November, 1974, I was present outside M.J. at the Tavern in the Town public house when the body of Eugene-Thomas-REILLY was recovered from the debris. This body was placed in a Police vehicle. I accompanied it to the Central Mortuary.
