I am Police Constable 2255 of the West Midlands Police. I am at present stationed at Steelhouse Lane Police Station.

On the night of Thursday, 21st November, 1974, I was on duty in New Street, City, I was engaged in connection with bomb incidents that had occurred at the Mulberry Bush and Tavern in the Town licensed houses at about 8.25 p.m. same date.

At about 4 a.m. Friday, 22nd November, 1974, I was present at the Tavern in the Town public house where the body of Lynn Jane BENNETT had been recovered from the debris. She was placed in a Police vehicle and taken to the Central Mortuary.

At the Mortuary I identified the body to Dr. Sandilands, who pronounced (Page 1...
