On 9.12.1954 we had a girl by our marriage who was christened Anne Hayss, she was born in St. Michaels Hospital Lichfield, but she has lived at the above address all her life. I can produce a birth certificate for Anne.

She attended Reason 2 Infants school moved to Reason 2 Junior School and finally went Reason 2 Senior School leaving at the age of 15 years.

On leaving school she served as an apprentice hairdresser for 3 years and then moved to Miss Selfridges as shop assistant.

The last time I saw Anne alive was when she went to bed on Wednesday night 20th November, that would be at about 11.30 p.m.

The next time that I saw her was when I attended to Central Mortuary 22nd November 1974 and identified her.

On Thursday 28th November 1974 I attended the Coroners Court in Birmingham and gave evidence of identification
