On Thursday, 21st November, 1974, I commenced duty at 8.15 a.m., and worked through the day.

At about 8.30 p.m. I received a call to go to Casualty Department as there was a major disaster.

I went immediately to Casualty and saw that several persons had been admitted suffering with major injuries. I assisted in dealing with these injuries.

At 9.05 p.m. I was called to examine three bodies which had been brought to the hospital by ambulance.

I entered the ambulance and certified Marilyn Faula NASH dead in the presence of the ambulance driver James TAYLOR.

In the same ambulance I certified Eugene Thomas REILLY ~~was~~
