On Thursday 21st November 1974 I got up to go to work and last saw Marilyn when she left for work at about 7.30 a.m.

I went to work myself and in the evening I went over to my girl friend,

We went out for the evening and returned to her house at about 11.00 p.m. I was told that my father had phoned up as he had seen the bombings on the television and he was worried about Paula. I attempted to phone the police in Birmingham but the lines were all engaged.

At about 12.30 a.m. the following morning I went to Jill's father by car to Birmingham. We went to the Police Headquarters where I gave a description of Paula. I then went to the Coroner's Department in Newton Street where I identified the body of my sister.

On Thursday 28th November 1974 I attended the Coroners Department at Newton Street and in the presence of the pathologist Dr. Davis and the ambulance driver James Taylor I formally identified the body of my sister Marilyn Paula Wash,
