At about 8.40pm on Thursday 21st November 1974 I was with Ambulance Driver Janet Taylor when we received a call to go to the Rotunda when we got there we went to the Tavern in the Town we went inside and from an alcove at the bottom of the stairs, which was on the right, I recovered a(Page 1...)

male body which I took to the General Hospital. I showed this body to Dr. Patterson in the ambulance and he certified death. I then took that body to the Central Mortuary, Newton St., **DPA**
