Mr. Charles Harper GREY was known to me for about 12 years and had lived at my house for the past two years. He was employed at the British Leyland Motor Co., at Longbridge as a mechanic and he never missed a day's work.

On Thursday, 21st November, 1974, I saw Charles Harper GREY at my house at 6.30 p.m. He left the house at 6.30 p.m. He left the house to go into town at 8 o'clock. At that time he was in good health and spirits.

On Thursday, 28th November, 1974, I went to the Central Mortuary in Newton Street, where I identified the body of Charles Harper GREY in the presence of Doctor SANDILANDS and Doctor HOULT, the Home Office Pathologist and Police Sergeant BEDFORD.

Charles Harper GREY was 43 years of age and was a native of Scotland."
