At about 8.30pm I received a call to go to Casualty Department as a major disaster had occurred.

I went immediately to casualty department and assisted in the treatment of persons suffering with major injuries.

At 9.08pm I went on board an ambulance and in the presence of Peter Noel GOODSHIP I certified Jane Elizabeth DAVIES (Page 1...) dead. The body was then taken from the hospital by ambulance.
